MUNICIPAL ELECTION

JUNE 10, 2023

The Town of Millsboro will hold a municipal election on June 10, 2023 to fill a Councilmember from District 2 seat, a Councilmember from District 3 seat and a Councilmember from an at-large seat on the Town Council. The polls will be open from 1:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. in the reception hall at Millsboro Town Center, 322 Wilson Highway, Millsboro, DE. The candidate running for the District 2 seat is Ronald O'Neal of 101 Pond Alley, Millsboro, DE; and the candidates running for the District 3 seat are Faye L. Lingo of 231 Laurel Road, Millsboro, DE and Matthew Davis of 29512 Glenwood Drive, Millsboro, DE; and the candidates running for the at-large seat are Larry Gum of 123 Millers Run, Millsboro, DE and Marty Presley of 27949 Roanoke Rapids Landing, Millsboro, DE.

Anyone wishing to cast a vote in the election must be a bona fide resident of the Town of Millsboro and be at least 18 years of age. Registered voters may vote in person or by absentee ballot. An Absentee Ballot Application must be completed and filed with the Town no later than 12:00pm on Friday, June 9, 2023. The last day an Absentee Ballot Application can be mailed to the requestor is Wednesday, June 7, 2023. After this date, each approved voter must come to Town Hall with identification to pick up his or her absentee ballot by noon on Friday, June 9, 2023. The ballot will not be provided to any person other than the approved voter. You may deliver it in person to Town Hall or mail it to: Millsboro Town Hall, Attn: Tammy Phillips, 322 Wilson Highway, Millsboro, DE, 19966, but it MUST be received by 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 10, 2023.
