NOTICE OF SOLICITATION FOR CANDIDATES
NOTICE OF REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS**

The **annual election for the Millsboro Town Council** shall be held at the Millsboro Town Center, 322 Wilson Highway, Millsboro, Delaware on Saturday, June 8, 2019 from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., prevailing time.

Council vacancies: Two (2) Town Council members shall be elected, each for a term of three (3) years. One (1) candidate will be from District 1, and one (1) candidate will be from District 2.

Notice of candidacy: Anyone wishing to file as a candidate for the election must file a written notice of filing with the town manager by no later than 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 15, 2019. Each candidate must file a “certificate of intention” or a “statement of organization” form. Slate will be posted from April 24, 2019 through May 15, 2019.

Candidacy requirements: Candidates for the Town Council must meet all of the following requirements: be at least twenty-one (21) years of age; shall have been a bona fide resident of the United States, State of Delaware, and Town for a period of at least one (1) year prior to the date of the election; and shall not have been convicted of a felony.
